Undecided and Exploring Students

The Advising Resource Center (ARC) advises undecided students until they declare a major. The ARC also provides helpful tools to assist students in determining their interests and selecting a major that is a good fit for them. All first-year undecided students meet with their adviser at least twice a year as outlined in the ARC Advising Policy.

Take advantage of an exciting new feature offered through the ARC: ARC E-portfolio is an online environment designed to help undecided students connect with each other, the advisers and campus resources.
