Nursing faculty member elected to national board

Oakland University associate nursing professor, Christina Sieloff, recently was elected to the American Nurses Association (ANA) Board of Directors as a Director at Large. The Board of Directors consists of five officers and 11 directors at large elected by delegates at the convention.

"It's an honor to be elected by nurses from across the country," Sieloff said. "I am committed to further improving the visibility of the work ANA and its constituent members do on a daily basis on behalf of the profession through the use of electronic communication."

Sieloff has been active in nursing at the local, state and national levels since 1979. She has served as newsletter editor, secretary and Director for Nursing Administration for the Detroit District Nurses Association, which is now the Southeast Chapter of Michigan Nurses Association. She also has served on the nominating committee, membership committee, reference committee and was a member of the Board of Directors representing Psychiatric and Mental Health Nursing.

In 1981, Sieloff joined the ANA Councils on Nursing Administration, Continuing Education and Psychiatric and Mental Health Nursing.
