Gift from Mr. and Mrs. C. A. Harlan of Birmingham of \$25,000 for Michigan State University-Oakland, \$10,000 of which is to be used for the creation of a scholarship in the name of Mrs. Harlan and \$15,000 to be used for library acquisitions.

On motion by Dr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Merriman, <u>it was voted</u> to accept with gratitude this generous gift from Trustee and Mrs. Harlan.
