Oakland University' women's basketball team has received a lot of publicity in the metro Detroit area and beyond throughout the Mid-Continent Conference Tournament and since making it to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in the team's history.

OU, the only team from Michigan in the 2002 Women's NCAA Basketball Tournament, received the number 16 seed in the Midwest Region and will play Vanderbilt, the top seed in the region, on Saturday, March 16, at 9:30 p.m. EST (8:30 p.m. CST) in Nashville, Tenn., at Memorial Gymnasium, Vanderbilt's home court.
