Committee Charge

- 1. To advise the President and the Athletic Director about matters affecting the academic and athletic integrity of intercollegiate athletics, including, but not limited to, matters affecting student-athlete welfare.
- 2. To advise the Athletic Director generally on policies for student-athletes including, but not limited to, standards of academic eligibility, student support and health, academic integrity and progress, equity, Title IX, and NCAA and Horizon League issues.
- 3. To assist Oakland University in meeting the NCAA and Horizon League standards for student-athlete welfare.
- 4. To receive timely and regular reports from the Athletic Director on matters related to athletics, including but not limited to current and proposed plans and policies that affect the athletic programs, including plans and policies on buildings, facilities, budgets, services, academic support and NCAA compliance; and to advise and make recommendations on same.
- 5. To receive reports and recommendations from other Senate committees and to advise and make recommendations to the Senate and its committees, as needed.
- 6. To take on additional duties as directed by the Senate Steering Committee.

<u>Meetings</u>

The Senate Intercollegiate Athletics Committee (SIAC) met monthly throughout the 2020-2021 academic vear.

Committee Goals

• All goals listed below were achieved with the exception of A2 (Get further clarification form Registrar's Office regarding transfer policies/procedures), D2 (Conduct Faculty Survey), and D3 (Conduct Faculty Training).

• D2 and D3 postponed due to COVID; SIAC thought it would be better to wait until the University was back to in person learning to complete these two goals – will complete these two goals during the 2021-22 academic year, pending in person learning. Will reconsider goal of getting further clarification about transfer policies/procedures during the next academic year.

 - 3. Clarification from Graduate Study regarding admissions and expectations; Ashley, Chris, Mari, and Evan Dermidoff will met with Grad Study on February 1.

- 3. Conduct Faculty Training Wait until in person; move to 2020-21 academic year
- 4. Develop Guidelines for make-up work for student-athlete Excused Absences Excused Absence Policy and Excusal Form on Senate Website and link incorporated into syllabus template; Guidelines were reviewed by the Senate Teaching and Learning Committee to obtain feedback.

Most Significant Committee Actions

- Revision of End of Season Surveys Committee worked with Ashley Stone for initial suggestions for revisions; Ashley Stone, Chris Stiller and Melissa McDonald completed revisions.
- Met with financial aid personnel to clarify policies and procedures related to financial aid.
- Supported Athletics and student-athletes on issues related to COVID
- Implemented University Excused Absence Policy within Athletics; finished Guidelines for making up work that is missed by students due to excusals permitted under the Excused Absence Policy.
- Participated in Athletics sponsored events related to Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (e.g. Tommy Shavers).
- Supported Athletics in regard to development efforts (e.g. Lepley, indoor golf, baseball/softball facilities)
- Developed Guidelines to advise post-bac transfer students and work cooperatively with Grad School; Document being reviewed/edited by Grad School (Clair Rammel and Brandy Randall); Coaching/Staff Education session be held on May 25.
- Faculty SIAC members provided input to Ashley Stone regarding University Academic Misconduct Policies.
