Naming opportunities available for SEHS

Oakland University's Board of Trustees have approved naming opportunities for Oakland University's new School of Education and Human Services building, which is currently under construction east of Varner Hall between the Varner Hall parking lot and Pioneer Drive.

Naming gifts received will help support current, and develop new, academic programs in the **School of Education and Human Services**, said Sue Goepp, vice president for University Relations.

"The new building for the School of Education and Human Services provides opportunities for our alumni and friends to make a significant difference in the future of SEHS," Goepp said. "Gifts of this nature transform the school – by providing endowments to keep equipment up to date, faculty support and curriculum enhancements, to name a few. In addition, naming a building, laboratory or space provides the donor a lasting recognition – connecting their name in perpetuity with OU."

The four-story, 132,000-square-foot-building is scheduled for an August 2002 completion. The J.M. Olson Corporation of St. Clair Shores began site contouring for the building in April. The project cost, shared by the university and the State of Michigan, is about \$31.5 million.
