## **Engineering professors awarded grants**

Professors Michael Polis and Zissimos Mourelatos of Oakland University's **School of Engineering and Computer Science** each won grants to continue their research.

Polis received \$54,918 from MEDC and \$9,538 from Autodesk Inc. for his project titled, "Economic Development Job Training - Autodesk-2." He also received a \$3,259 award from MEDC and Altair Engineering Inc. for his project titled, "Economic Development Job Training - Altair Engineering Inc."

Professor Zissimos Mourelatos received a \$25,000 award from General Motors Corporation for his project titled, "Optimal Design of an Automatic Transmission Park System for Engagement Speed Performance Considering Uncertainty."
