Workshop aims to strengthen communication with parents

Oakland University's **School of Education and Human Services** will present "Strengthening Parent-Professional Partnerships," a workshop for educators, counseling, and community support professionals. The course will be held each Saturday in October from 8:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. at Oakland University. The deadline to register is Friday, Sept. 19.

Donna Lackie, MSW, CSW, ASCW, will be the course instructor. Lackie, a social worker and administrator with more than 20 years experience in prevention and early childhood programming, is the primary prevention coordinator for Oakland Schools. She coordinates Oakland County's Brain Resource Team and authored "Their Future Is In Our Hands," a publication for new parents.

The workshop will include communication strategies to build professional trust and respect, understand parent perspectives, identify family needs and intervention services for children, access community supports, and work with culturally diverse families and specialized parent populations.

The cost is \$295 if enrolled for continuing education units (SB-CEUs). Participants have the option to take the course for two university graduate credits.
