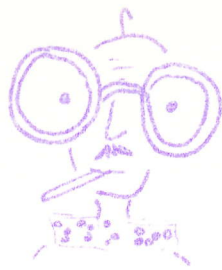

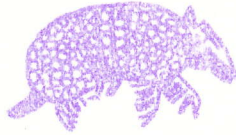
EDITORIAL: LBJ'S LOST WAR
