Women's team advances to semifinals

Oakland University's **women's basketball team** defeated IUPUI for the first time this season in the quarterfinals of the Mid-Continent Conference Tournament and advance to the second semifinal game on Monday, March 4, at the War Memorial Coliseum in Fort Wayne, Ind.

No. 2 Oakland (15-13) will play No. 6 Oral Roberts (13-15) in the semifinals. The pre-game show begins around 2 p.m. You can listen to the live broadcast on the **OU Athletics** Web site.

The winner of the semifinals will go on to play in the championship game on Tuesday, March 5, at 6 p.m. against the winner of the first semifinal game between No. 1 Valparaiso (23-5) and No. 5 Chicago State (11-17). The first semifinal game is Monday, March 4, at 11 a.m.

The winner of the Mid-Con Tournament will earn the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

In the quartefinals, the Golden Grizzlies defeated IUPUI 63-53. Katie Wolfe (Cedar Springs/Cedar Springs) and Sarah Judd (Eastpointe/Harper Woods Regina), both first-team All-Mid-Con players, combined for 41 points.

This is OU's third appearance in the Mid-Continent Conference Tournament. In last year's tournament, OU, the No. 1 seed, advanced to the finals by defeating Valparaiso 76-68 and IUPUI 80-73. But Oral Roberts proved too strong in the tournament final, defeating the Golden Grizzlies 61-46.
