

## **OUWB Publication List: 2017 Preliminary Report**

The Medical Library is pleased to publish the preliminary 2017 OUWB Publication Report featuring the published work of our OUWB faculty, staff, and students!

This year's report features 707 citations including 497 peer-reviewed articles, 28 books & book chapters, 9 MedEdPORTAL items, and 100 student-authored works. In addition, OUWB faculty published the most in these five journals:

- International Journal of Radiation Oncology,
   Biology, Physics
- Journal of Neurosurgery
- American Journal of Cardiology
- Ophthalmic Surgery Lasers and Imaging Retina
- BMJ Case Reports

#### Resource News: PubMed Labs

The National Library of Medicine has announced that they expect to launch a major "refresh" of the PubMed interface in early 2019.

If you would like to get an idea of some of the features under consideration, visit <a href="PubMed Labs">PubMed Labs</a>, where you can try out new features and tools that might be incorporated into PubMed based on user feedback.



PubMed Labs uses a new search algorithm to more accurately find the best matches for your search, has a modern design that displays well on mobile devices, and includes "snippets" to help you more easily identify articles of interest. Try it out, and don't forget to provide feedback!


## Resource of the Month: Scopus

#### What is it?

<u>Scopus</u> is a large abstract and citation database of peer-reviewed research literature with more than 20,500 titles from more than 5,000 international publishers. Scopus offers researchers a quick, easy, and comprehensive resource to support their research needs in the scientific, technical, medical, and social sciences fields as well as in the arts and humanities. It also contains tools that track, analyze, and visualize scholarly work.

#### How do I access it?

#### Why should I bother?

The breadth and depth of subject coverage supports interdisciplinary research, and Scopus's bibliographic and journal metric and visualization tools allow faculty to track their scholarly impact.

- Easy search interface that allows searching by topic, author, keyword, and other techniques
- Author Profile pages that allow faculty to track their scholarly impact including citation counts, h-index, and other metrics
- Journal impact information that is helpful when selecting where to publish

Scopus has a number of online tutorials to help you use its advanced features, or, as always, any of the Medical Library faculty will be happy to provide a one-on-one training session.
