**M. Miller:** If this money is taken away from these items, if it were left there it wouldn't be spent anyway? Yield to Allen.

**Allen:** For a suggestion, since there is a lot of money to be used, lets encourage students to come to the program and do a question & answer type of thing to give out scholarships. This way we will know that there were students that were educated about the program.

**Brendan:** Right now the money is dead, so I don't mind putting it somewhere else. It's happened before...going under budget.

**Panchenko:** If this went through, why wouldn't we pay someone to come and speak?

**Waquad:** The committee decided that we wanted speakers to come in that they would listen to. We had speakers come form outside; we want students to listen to people from Oakland. We want students to be influenced by the speaker.

**Ewing:** The money is coming from line items on the budget not being used, why is there so much debate about this? If they don't use all the money, they don't use all money. This doesn't close doors, it opens them. Yield to Stevens

**Stevens:** We could still spend money on the events that money is being removed from. We should take all money out of the dead money.
