## Changes to athletics staff announced

With the start of Oakland University's 2004-05 athletics season just days away, Director of Athletics Jack Mehl announced several changes to his athletics administrative staff in time for the start of the new school year.

Mark Doman, assistant athletics director for marketing for the past three years, recently resigned from his position to accept a new position at Oakland University as a visiting professor in OU's **School of Education and Human Services**.

"We are so pleased with the work that Mark Doman has done for the department over the course of the last several years," Mehl said. "We also are equally excited for him as he begins his new career as a visiting professor in the School for Education and Human Services."

Moving into Doman's position is Denise McGee, who served as the assistant athletics director for operations and senior women's administrator. She has been with the **Athletics Department** for five years and will remain as the senior women's administrator in her new position.

Taking the position of assistant athletics director for operations is Eric Stephan, who was the associate head coach for men's basketball and has been on head coach Greg Kampe's staff for the past 17 seasons.

"In filling Mark's position, we are fortunate to have a professional talent pool capable of stepping into his key role on short notice. Denise McGee had considerable marketing experience prior to assuming her former position, and likewise, Eric Stephan has had previous facilities experience at Oakland," Mehl said. "I am confident that the department will not miss a beat during this short period of transition."
