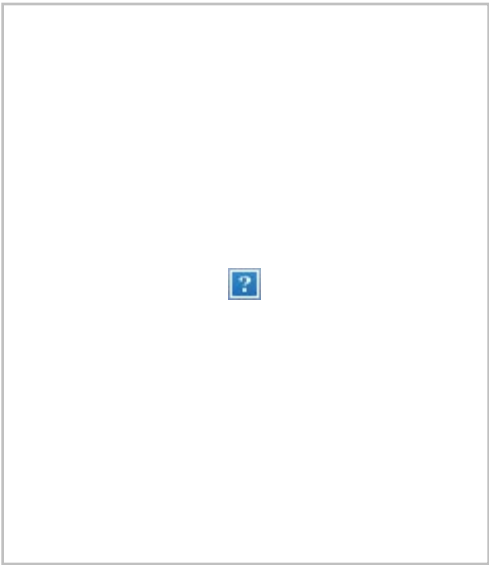

The Medical Library is pleased to publish the preliminary [2016 OUSB Publication Report](#) featuring the published work of our OUSB faculty, staff, and students!

This year's report features 740 citations including 382 peer-reviewed articles, 208 published meeting abstracts, 4 books, 44 book chapters, 5 MedEdPORTAL items, and 82 student-authored works. In addition, OUSB faculty published the most in these five journals.

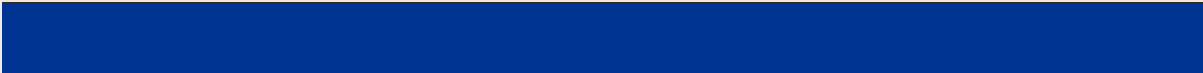
