FULBRIGHTS AVAILABLE

Announcements of remaining Fulbright opportunities for university lecturing and postdoctoral research abroad during the next academic year may be consulted at the office of OU's faculty Fulbright advisor, William Schwab (English), 370 South Foundation Hall. Most of the remaining openings are lectureships, chiefly in biology, chemistry, economics and business, engineering, the teaching of English as a foreign language, literature, mathematics, and physics. Schwab also has information on postdoctoral research awards for 1971-72 under programs sponsored by the North Atlantic Treaty Organization and the Southeast Asia Treaty Organization.
