Larry Hagman to speak at lecture series

Larry Hagman, best known for his starring role in the 1965 comedy series "I Dream of Jeannie" and his role as J.R. Ewing in the 1977 television series "Dallas," will take "A Walk Down Memory Lane" when he speaks at Macomb's Town Hall Lecture Series on Tuesday, Oct. 14, at 11 a.m. at the Ukranian Cultural Center, 26601 Ryan Road, in Warren.

The recipient of a life-saving liver transplant, Hagman served as the national spokesperson for the 1996 U.S. Transplant Games presented by the National Kidney Foundation. He received the foundation's Public Service Award that year for his efforts in heightening public awareness about the importance of organ donation.

This lecture-luncheon series benefits the Oakland University scholarship program and has awarded more than \$350,000 to deserving Macomb County students. More than 25 percent of the university's population is from Macomb County.
