Dear 7016,

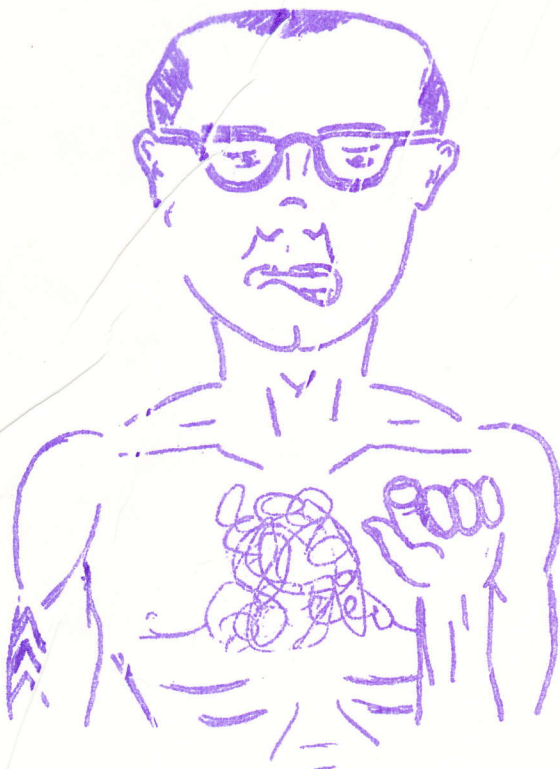
