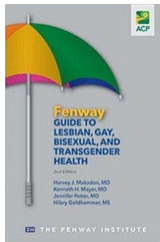
It's National LGBT Health Awareness Week! March 25 - 29

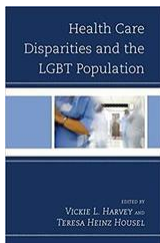

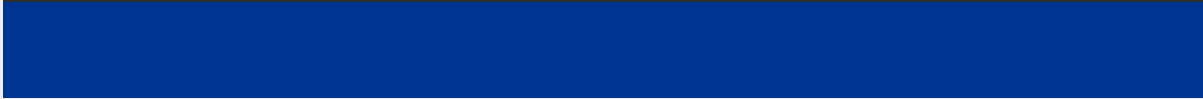
