by Nezzie Kicapoux

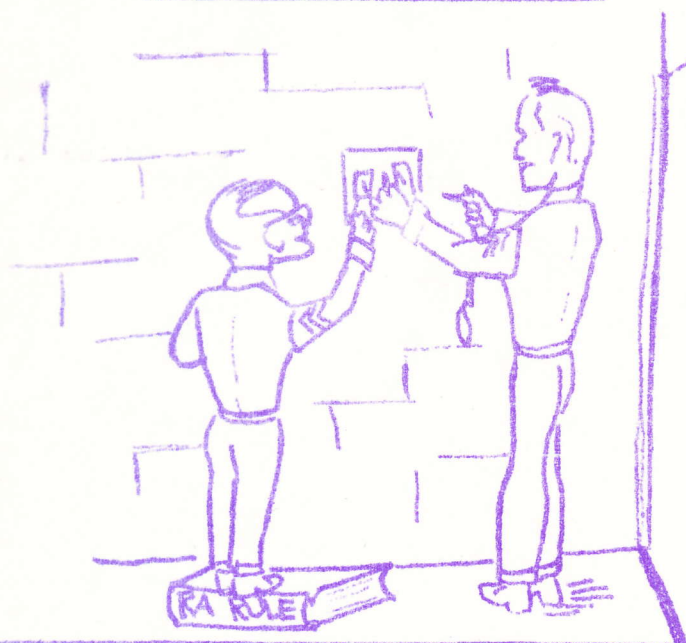
Strange, it really seems that I,
