Members of the Academic Standing and Honors (ASH) Committee for the past academic year were: William Keane, Chair, fall term (School of Education and Human Services); Edward Haworth Hoeppner, Chair, winter term (Department of English): Margaret Pigott (Department of Rhetoric, Communication and Journalism): Darrell Schmidt (Department of Mathematics and Statistics); Vijayan Sugumaran (School of Business Administration); Duane Moore (winter term, School of Education and Human Services--replacing William Keane); Karen Lloyd, Ivy Horn, Charles Clark. Only faculty members are voting members of ASH.

The Faculty Senate's charge to the Academic Standing and Honors Committee is "to review, propose and implement policies concerning academic probation, separation, and readmission; to present to the Senate the Registrar's list of candidates for graduation with any recommendations for deletions or additions to the list; and to review and transmit to the Senate nominees for University honors." The committee met shortly after the conclusion of each term.

In addition to handling the usual run of dismissal appeals, the committee this past year began to discuss the current methods used to determine the numbers of students grated honors upon graduation, with an eye toward examining the proportion of honors granted by various departments and schools. The results of the committee's deliberations as regards dismissals and appeals are as follows:

Summer 2000: Total dismissals, 8; dismissals rescinded, 0; appeals, 1, appeals denied, 0; appeals granted, 1.

Fall, 2000: Total dismissals, 56; dismissals rescinded, 33; appeals, 17, appeals denied, 7; appeals granted, 10.

Winter, 2001: Total dismissals, 136; dismissals rescinded, 42; appeals, 27, appeals denied, 18; appeals granted, 9.

Spring, 2001: Total dismissals, 23; dismissals rescinded, 15; appeals, 5, appeals denied, 2; appeals granted, 3.
