May, Treasurer, be and is hereby authorized to execute any and all certificates to effectuate and carry out the sale of said securities.

Recommendation for the completion of the purchase of approximately 3 1/3 acres of land for \$9,075 from W. E. Panucha for the Meadow Brook estate.

On motion by Mr. Brody, seconded by Mr. Harlan, it was voted to approve purchase of the above-mentioned property.

On April 15, 1958 bids were received on the first building at MSU-O. These bids covered in addition to the main building, fixed laboratory equipment, roads, parking areas, walks.

Mr. and Mrs. George E. Wyman of Pontiac have donated \$50 to be used for the acquisition of necessary items at the Oakland Branch of Michigan State University. It has been suggested that it might be advisable to authorize a Michigan State University-Oakland Development Fund and possibly a board or corporation to promote gifts and grants for this purpose.
