OU offers first doctoral program in Macomb County

Oakland University's School of Education and Human Services (SEHS) will offer its Ph.D. in Education with a concentration in Educational Leadership at the Macomb Intermediate SchoolDistrict (ISD) building in Clinton Township. It is the only Ph.D. program currently being offered by any university on-site in Macomb County. The deadline to register for this program is March 1.

The Ph.D. major in educational leadership is designed to develop individuals who can provide leadership to educational practice in the 21st Century, whether through roles in public and private school and district leadership or by contributing to research and teaching about educational policy and practice.

Core concepts in the program include systems thinking, the leadership capacity and roles of all staff, the application of theory to practice, data-based management, and grounded theory.

Classes will begin in Fall 2004. The degree requires 76 credits beyond the master's degree with courses taken in a cohort model. Program details are available online at <http://www.oakland.edu/profdev>.
