OU professor named as ACE Fellow

The American Council on Education (ACE) recently named Robert Wiggens, associate professor of Curriculum, Instruction and Leadership at Oakland University, as an ACE Fellow for academic year 2000-2001.

The ACE Fellows Program, established in 1965, is designed to strengthen institutions and leadership in American higher education by identifying and preparing promising faculty and senior administrators for responsible positions in college and university administration.

Each ACE Fellow focuses on issues of concern to the nominating institution while spending an academic year working with college or university presidents and senior officers at a host institution. Fellows are included in the highest level of decision making while participating in administrative activities and contributing to a project designed to benefit their home institution. Fellows attend three weeklong seminars on higher education issues, read extensively in the field and engage in other activities to enhance their knowledge about the challenges and opportunities confronting higher education. In addition to having faculty selected for this rare opportunity, an institution also can host an ACE Fellow.

The American Council on Education membership includes more than 1600 accredited degree-granting institutions and more than 200 higher education associations and organizations. ACE coordinates national public policy positions on higher education issues and provides leadership for improving educational standards, policies and procedures.

Oakland University is a comprehensive state-supported institution of higher education located in Oakland County, Michigan. The university has 110 bachelor's degree programs and 63 graduate degree and certificate programs. Dedicated to preparing learners for the 21st-century workplace and society, Oakland University is organized into the College of Arts and Sciences and the Schools of Business Administration, Education and Human Services, Engineering and Computer Science, Health Sciences, Nursing and the Honors College.
