THIS IS <u>OUR</u> LIFE Veteran Stratford actor and director, Joseph Shaw, will direct Meadow Brook Theatre's second play of the 1970-71 season, *Life With Father*. The comedy, one of the most successful Broadway hits in history, begins this week in the Wilson Hall theatre. Check the calendar for performance times and the MBT box office for tickets. Shaw, who played major roles at the Stratford Shakespeare Festival for six years, returns to Meadow Brook where he appeared two years ago in a production of Shaw's *The Apple Cart*. He appears regularly in CBC television dramas and had feature roles in several films, including "Heart Farm" with Sandy Dennis and "Change of Mind" with Raymond St. Jacques, both yet to be released.

CHEKHOV NIGHT ADDED

The Studio Company of the Academy of Dramatic Art will stage a special mid-season production called "An Evening With Anton Chekhov" this week and next. The program features two short comedy sketches, The Proposal and On the Harmfulness of Tobacco, plus large segments from two major plays, The Seagull and The Three Sisters. Performance times are 8:15 p.m. this Thursday, Friday and Saturday, and the following Wednesday through Saturday. Tickets may be bought at 130 Performing Arts, at the Office of Commuter and Campus Programs, or at the door on the night of each performance. The new Studio Company Theatre is on the southeast corner of the Performing Arts Building.

COLLINS IS ELECTED Walter S. Collins (music) was elected president of the College Music Society, a 2,000-member organization of music professors in the U.S. and Canada, at the recent internal meeting held in Toronto. The College Music Society is broadly constituted of artists and scholars from all types of collegiate institutions. Its concerns are divided among the six subdivisions of composition, performance, music education, theory, ethnomusicology, and musicology.
