Ji-Eun Lee Publishes Articles

The second article, Examination of prospective teachers' perceptions on mathematical concepts and their potential teaching strategies, has been published in Journal of KSME Series D: Research in Mathematical Education.

Darlene Groomes Publishes Article

Darlene Groomes, associate professor in HDCS, published an article entitled, *Utilizing assistive dogs in integrated employment: Multidisciplinary elements to consider for individuals with ASD* in the Journal of Vocational Rehabilitation, 40, 165-173.

This article was a collaborative writing effort among HDCS graduate students, Andrew Clemons and Sandra Hulme; CNS graduate, Kelly Kort; and Professor Emeritus from University of North Carolina, Dr. Gary Mesibov.

The writing summarizes the outcomes of a human-animal interaction study conducted in collaboration with Oakland's Autism Center. Dr. Groomes was the Principal Investigator who examined the effects of interactions with dogs and improving adaptive social behaviors in adolescents with autism spectrum disorders (ASD). While results suggest that HAI may provide a means of helping adolescents to acquire adaptive social behaviors, it became important to then highlight multiple disciplinary considerations when utilizing assistive dogs in integrated employment settings for individuals with ASD.

OU Night at Comerica Park - August 13, 2014


