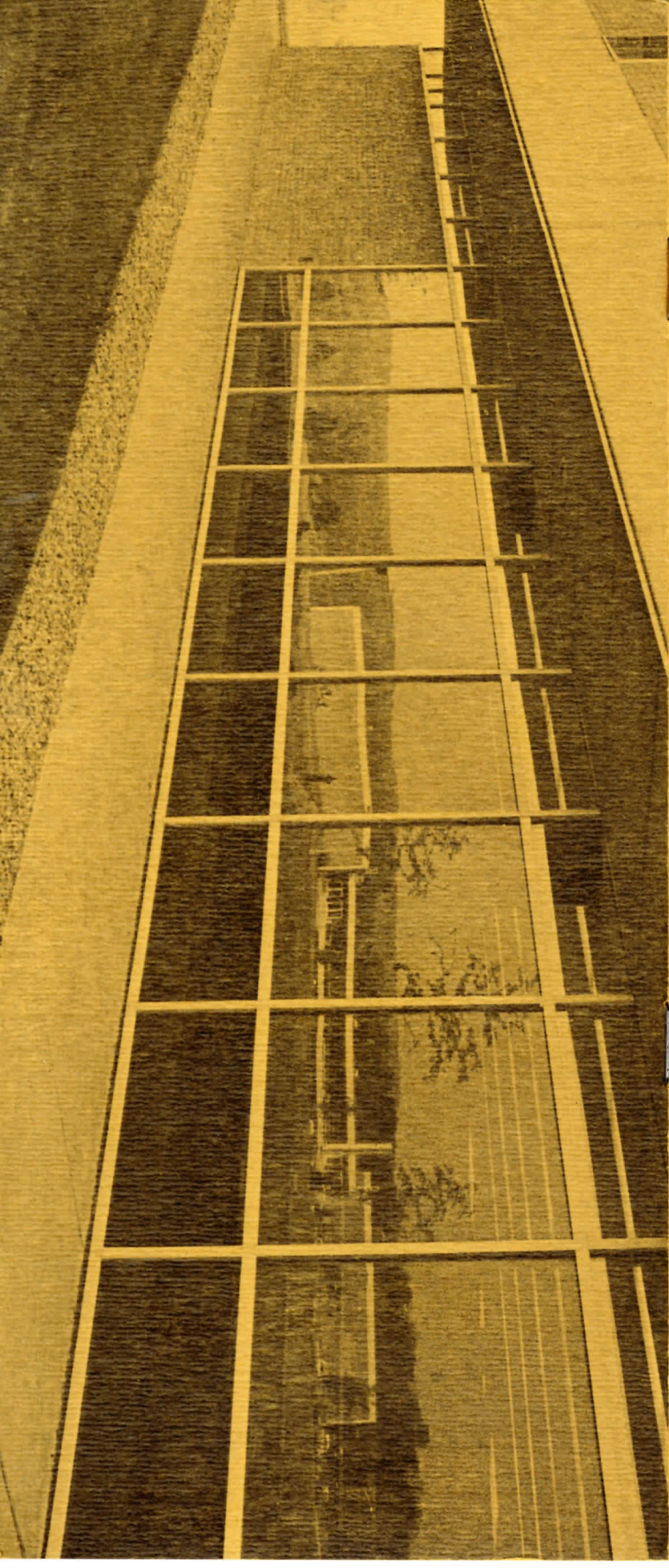
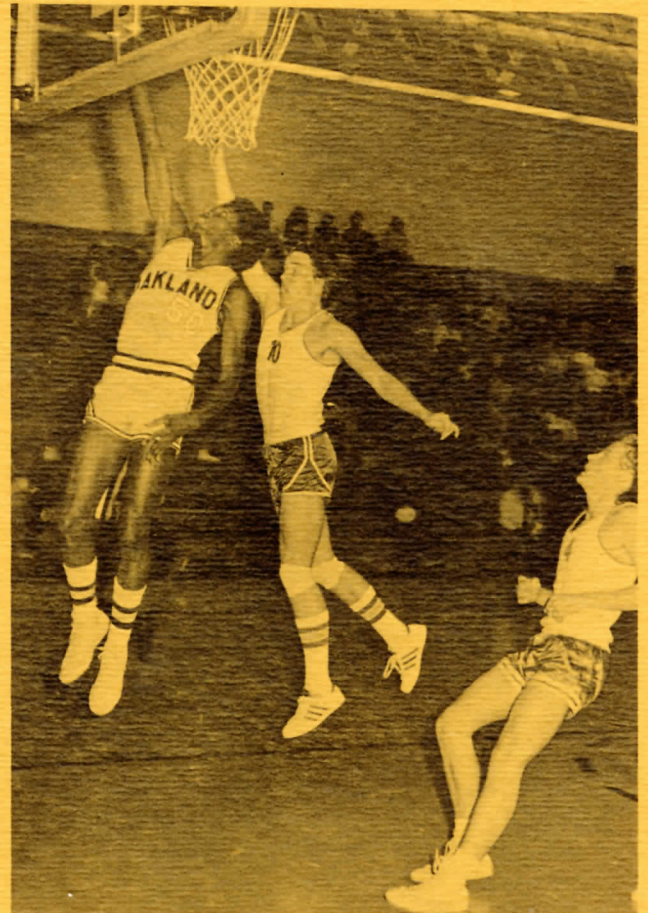

Gene was raised in Detroit and graduated from Wayne State University in 1954. As a basketball player he ranked among the career leaders in rebounding and games played for Wayne State. During his three and one-half years in the service, he was named to several Air Force All-Star Teams. He received his Masters Degree in Guidance and Counseling from the University of Michigan in 1963. Gene is presently an Associate Professor of Education at Oakland and teaches sports officiating and activity classes for the Physical Education Department. He lives in Troy with his wife Gaynell

(Gay), his eleven year old son Derrick, and his daughter Indira, who is seven.

Gene started a basketball program from scratch when Murray-Wright High School opened in Detroit in 1965. He was voted the Detroit News Coach of the year for guiding his team to the Detroit Public School League Championship in 1967-68. The following year he became the head basketball coach at Oakland University. In his five seasons at OU, Gene has compiled a record of 63-59, and has done a marvelous job of developing the basketball program — which had only one full season in before he joined the staff.

Coach Boldon ran a basketball clinic last summer at Albion College and has plans to organize an instructional clinic at Oakland in 1974.

Terry, 26, graduated from Allen Park High School in 1966 where he played three years of varsity baseball and basketball. He entered Wayne State University in the fall of 1966 and again lettered in both baseball and basketball. He graduated from Wayne in 1970 with a major in Physical Education. Terry was drafted by the Minnesota Twins baseball team upon graduation from college. He spent three years in their organization including stops at Auburn of the New York Parent League, Clinton, Iowa, in the Midwest League and at Orlando in the Florida League where

he was under the direction of former American League pitching star Early Wynn. Terry re-entered Wayne State University to further his career goals of teaching and coaching and gained a Masters Degree in Physical Education in 1973.

Terry resides in Allen Park and is now teaching junior high school in Detroit besides his coaching duties at Oakland.
