OU hosts Surf 'n Splash summer camp

Oakland University's **School of Business Administration** and the **Department of Campus Recreation** is hosting the Surf 'n Splash Summer Camp 2001 for children ages 11-13. The camp runs from 8:30 a.m.- 4 p.m. in five-day intervals during the weeks of June 18-22 and 25-29 and July 9-13 and 16-20.

The summer camp incorporates a unique mix of computer classes and recreational activities. Campers will learn about the Internet, including web page development, word processing, spreadsheets and databases. The recreation department also will host activities including swimming, basketball, jump rope, soccer, outdoor activities and wellness exercises.

The cost of the camp is \$295 per week. If paid before June 8, the cost is reduced to \$275 per week. Class sizes are limited.
