1. Motion from the College of Arts and Sciences to approve a new Constitution. (Mr. Downing, Mr. Andrews)

MOVED that the Senate recommend to the President and the Board approval of the new Constitution of the College of Arts and Sciences.

Second reading: Debatable and eligible for final vote at this meeting. Not amendable under Senate protocol for constitutions.

A memorandum (2/15/96) detailing a "Sense of the Assembly" relating to the selection of chairpersons was distributed to the Senate at the February 15th meeting as background information; the text appears in the February 15 minutes.

2. Motion from the Graduate Council (Mr. Dahlgren, Mr. Tower)

MOVED that the Senate recommend to the President and the Board the establishment of a program in Accounting leading to the Master of Accounting (M.Acc.) degree.

- 1. Motion from the Graduate Council (Mr. Dahlgren)

MOVED that the Senate recommend to the President and the Board the establishment of a program in Software Engineering leading to the Master of Science Degree.
