In her more than 30 years at Oakland University, Mildred Merz has achieved a distinguished record of service, including longstanding contributions to the Graduate Council, the University Committee on Undergraduate Instruction (UCUI), and the Library Committee on Appointment and Promotion, chairing that body through numerous searches and revisions of the review criteria. She also has served on the Faculty Reemployment Committee (FRPC) (including multiple terms as chair). Her energy, grasp of detail and willingness to go the extra mile are always evident. At the state level, Merz is an influential voice for Oakland University in the statewide Collection Development in Academic Libraries Group. By cultivating good relationships with other libraries in the state she furthered statewide cooperation in collection development.
