The men's basketball team wrapped up a record-setting season, breaking league records in wins (17) and conference winning percentage (.944), along with setting new OU records in wins (26) and posted an 11-game winning streak that ended in the first round of the NCAA tournament versus No. 18 Pittsburgh.
