RAD is not a Martial Arts program. Our courses are taught by highly trained instructors from the Oakland University Police Department and each student is provided with a workbook and reference manual.

The 18 hour Basic RAD class is free to OU students and affiliates and \$35.00 for non-students and non-affiliates.
