#### FROM THE SCHOOL OF EDUCATION AND HUMAN SERVICES

From OUCARES Program Coordinator Stephanie Laubach:

I have been with OUCARES for just over two years and it has been my pleasure to watch our programs for people with autism grow and develop over that time. Notably, OUCARES has put a large focus on offering supports for teens and adults with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASDs). We are still running programs for children and younger teens as well, but our original younger families are getting older and there is an obvious lack of services for these teens and adults. OUCARES is trying to help fill this gap.

I am very proud to be a part of the team that offers these innovative and quality services for the older populations of individuals with ASD. For example, in summer 2015, OUCARES offered the first camp of its kind, a life skills camp for 12 adults with autism, to teach them important independent living skills like money management, cooking, and job preparedness.

In 2016, we have a number of **Evening Enrichment events** planned to inform the community about issues related to adults on the spectrum, and we are collaborating with SEHS graduate students in career counseling to offer a Career Prep Workshop for adults with ASD. These are just a few of the great things we are planning. Please stop by the OUCARES offices to learn more about our programs and to see how you can get involved to help improve the lives of people impacted by ASD. I look forward to seeing you soon.
