OU offering personal financial planning program

Oakland University's **School of Business Administration** is offering a Personal Financial Planning Program beginning the week of April 30. Classes will from 7-9:30 p.m. at Derby Middle School in Birmingham and on Saturday from 9 a.m.-12:30 p.m. at the Macomb University Center in Clinton Township.

The program is a Certified Financial Planner Board (CFP) registered program and consists of eight courses designed to train students in all aspects of financial planning. After completing the program, students earn a Certificate in Personal Financial Planning and are eligible to sit for the CFP exam.

A Personal Financial Planning Assistant Certificate program also is available for students, which is designed for support staff in the financial planning business who want to learn the essentials of financial planning.
