RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees extends to Trustee Emerson its best wishes for happiness and the hope that she will continue her association with Oakland University.

Chair Kramer thanked Trustee Emerson for her service and especially her leadership on diversity issues on campus.

After discussion, Trustee Schlusser, seconded by Trustee Flynn, moved approval of the recommendation, and the motion was unanimously approved by those present.

Chair Kramer presented the Resolution Honoring Jay B. Shah recommendation as set forth in the agenda item.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees, the President, and the entire Oakland University community publicly express their deep appreciation and gratitude to Trustee Jay B. Shah for his dedicated service and wise counsel; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that Trustee Shah be designated as Trustee Emeritus with all of the attendant rights and privileges of the position; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be provided to Trustee Shah to convey the esteem in which he is held by the Board of Trustees, the President, and the University community; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees extends to Trustee Shah its best wishes for happiness and the hope that he will continue his association with Oakland University.

Chair Kramer thanked Trustee Shah for his service to the University especially for his advice and leadership on the new construction projects on campus.

After discussion, Trustee Schlusser, seconded by Trustee Flynn, moved approval of the recommendation, and the motion was unanimously approved by those present.

Approval of Authorization for Custodial Services Contract

Mr. Terry Stollsteimer, Associate Vice President for Facilities Management, presented the Approval of Authorization for Custodial Services Contract recommendation as set forth in the agenda item.

RESOLVED, that the Vice President for Finance and Administration be authorized to negotiate and execute a custodial services agreement with the vendor selected by the Board of Trustees; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the total cost of the custodial services agreement will not exceed, the selected vendor's cost as noted in Attachment A without prior Board of Trustees review and approval, with the exception of increased cost directly related to changes in minimum wage laws which will be adhered to and enforced; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement be reviewed and approved by the Office of the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel prior to execution, and be in compliance with the law and with University policies and regulations, and conform to the legal standards and policies of the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel.

Chair Kramer indicated that there was not a quorum to take a vote on the Resolution and asked for a motion to adjourn the matter until the October 22, 2014 Board meeting.

Trustee Ronald E. Robinson commented that from a reputational risk standpoint the Board should give serious consideration to the criticisms publicized concerning ARAMARK.

After discussion, Trustee Schlusel, seconded by Trustee Stolicker, moved approval of the recommendation to adjourn the matter until the October 22, 2014 Board meeting, and the motion was approved with five positive votes and one negative vote by Trustee Robinson.

Commercial Banking Services

Mr. James L. Hargett, Assistant Vice President and Controller, presented the Commercial Banking Services recommendation as set forth in the agenda item.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Vice President for Finance and Administration to execute all agreements necessary to establish and maintain commercial treasury banking, purchasing cards and payables solutions with Fifth Third Bank; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees authorizes the Vice President for Finance and Administration to execute all agreements necessary to establish and maintain merchant card services with US Bank; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreements be reviewed and approved by the Office of the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel prior to execution, and be in compliance with the law and with University policies and regulations, and conform to the legal standards and policies of the Vice President for Legal Affairs and General Counsel.

After discussion, Trustee Richard L. DeVore, seconded by Trustee Flynn, moved approval of the recommendation, and the motion was unanimously approved by those present.

Appointment of Board Chair and Vice Chair

Chair Kramer presented the Board of Trustees Ad Hoc Nominating Committee's recommendation for the Appointment of Board Chair and Vice Chair as set forth in the agenda item.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees Ad Hoc Nominating Committee recommends approval of the appointment of Trustee Mark E. Schlusel as Chair of the Board of Trustees for a one (1) year term; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees Ad Hoc Nominating Committee recommends approval of the appointment of Trustee Richard L. DeVore as Vice Chair of the Board of Trustees for a one (1) year term.

Chair Kramer thanked Vice Chair Flynn for his service to the university and his friendship.

Chair Kramer indicated that a committee was appointed to recommend the new Board Chair and Vice Chair and that the recommendation was for new Chair to be Trustee Schlusel and the new Vice Chair to be Trustee DeVore.

After discussion, Trustee Flynn, seconded by Trustee Robinson moved approval of the recommendation, and the motion was unanimously approved by those present.

E. Other Items for Consideration/Action that May Come Before the Board

Trustee Emerson stated that it has been a true privilege and honor to serve as a Trustee of Oakland University. As a graduate, the University has transformed her life as it has transformed other lives. Although challenges remain, she believes that the Board, faculty, staff and administration will keep students in the forefront and understands why we are really here.


