Wilson Boulevard to close for repaving

Among the improvement projects taking place this summer at Oakland University are road repairs. The university is preparing to repave Wilson Boulevard and the Oakland Center loading dock. The project requires that these areas and parking lot 2, located adjacent to Wilson Hall, be completely closed to all traffic beginning at 6 a.m. on Monday, Aug. 12. The boulevard and loading dock will reopen at 8 a.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 27.

"The pavement and curbs are simply breaking up in these areas," said OU Senior Architect Khales Dahr. "We also had to do some excavation in that area in June to replace a high temperature water line. We didn't patch the roadway then because we knew we'd be replacing the entire stretch of pavement now.

"We'll do our best to accommodate any important deliveries to the Oakland Center, but the drives will be closed to the public during the duration of the project."
