Adrienne Bass to be recognized in athletics Hall of Honor

Oakland University's Director of Alumni Relations Adrienne Bass will be recognized at this year's Hall of Honor ceremony hosted by the Department of Athletics.

Bass is the 2010 recipient of the George Wibby Award, which recognizes an outstanding campus partner to Oakland Athletics.

While serving Oakland's Alumni Association, Bass has been an avid supporter of the Athletics department, leveraging the resources of both organizations to help create a dynamic partnership that serves the interests of the university, according to Simon Dover, associate director of athletics at Oakland.
