APPROVAL OF MINUTES

GRADUATE COUNCIL ORIENTATION/REFRESHER

- Megan Harris provided a background and refresher on the Graduate Council. The Council is a permanent standing committee of Oakland University Senate. It was established to make recommendations to the Senate, Graduate Council advises on proposed and existing graduate programs, including recommendations for program suspension and discontinuation. Other duties include; Seeking the advice (when necessary) of other appropriate University bodies concerning the impact of new programs or changes in existing programs. Rendering advice to the Dean of Graduate School on all matters concerning graduate program administration, and support and ongoing graduate study activities as the Dean of the Graduate School may request. Conducting periodic reviews of graduate programs with reports of findings submitted to the University Senate and other appropriate bodies. Appointing subcommittees as necessary to assist in recommendations. The subcommittees shall report their recommendations to the Graduate Council in carrying out its responsibilities. Recommending to the president all candidates for graduate degrees.

- Brandy discussed Graduate enrollment for Winter 2021 and strategies to encourage enrollment.

Program modification for the DScPT to PhD program

After discussion, Council will submit additional questions to Dr. Thompson and readdress the modification at the next meeting.

• Graduate Council Award Subcommittee

The Award Subcommittee will remain a committee of the Graduate Council. Additional ad hoc committees will be developed to include outside experts to work with subcommittee members to choose applicants/awardees. An loan/scholarship award has been created. Brandy will work on providing additional information to the subcommittee.

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• Duolingo and IELTS Indicator

Brandy submitted a proposed policy update to the English Language Proficiency Policy. Duolingo and IELTS Indicator will be added to the list of acceptable tests providing evidence of English language proficiency. The cutoff for Duolingo will be 105. Acceptance of the IELTS Indicator will be temporary, and will cease when there is a return to normal operations post-pandemic. Performance of students admitted with Duolingo will be reviewed in one year to evaluate whether this provides a good measure of students' ability to be successful at Oakland, as compared to the ELP exams that have historically been used.
