## Road construction planned at campus main entrance

Over the next several days, the City of Auburn Hills will be doing road construction at the intersection of University Drive and Squirrel Road, which may have a significant impact on traffic to and from campus. Students, faculty, staff and campus visitors should plan accordingly.

Construction is scheduled to begin Wednesday, Sept. 15, and continue through Friday, Sept. 24. On Sept. 15-17, the southwest corner of the intersection will be broken up and repoured, and the two right lanes of eastbound University Drive and southbound Squirrel Road will be closed. However, vehicles will be able to use the other lanes.

Starting Monday, Sept. 20, through Friday, Sept. 24, the center section of the intersection for eastbound University Drive will be broken up and repoured. Eastbound University Drive traffic will have to turn right onto southbound Squirrel Road, then U-turn onto northbound Squirrel Road and turn right on University Drive to enter the university's main entrance.
