Campus electrical interruptions rescheduled

Due to unforeseen problems with underground conduits, the two rounds of electrical power interruptions that were to take place on campus Thursday, August 30, have been rescheduled for Friday, August 30.

The power interruptions are necessary for the upgrade and replacement of underground power lines and electrical switchgear in individual buildings to improve the reliability of the university's power supply. Friday's work should complete the first phase of the project. The second and final phase will be completed next summer.

Friday's momentary power interruptions will affect all buildings on the west campus between 6 and 10 a.m., and 5 and 7 p.m.

"There's not an easy, convenient way to perform these types of improvements needed on our campus," said Lynne Schaefer, vice president for finance and administration. "The cooperation and patience of the entire campus community during these trying experiences has been remarkable and is greatly appreciated."
