OU, Detroit Symphony Orchestra host summer institute

Oakland University and the Detroit Symphony Orchestra (DSO) will host a two-week summer institute July 16-30 at the Meadow Brook Music Festival on the university's campus.

Young Michigan musicians will be given the opportunity to improve their instrumental and ensemble abilities, alongside some of America's finest symphonic musicians. Students will stay in university dorms, attend courses in Orchestral Literature and Music Theory, receive private lessons and attend group rehearsals.

Auditions were held in March and April and a select number of musicians were selected.
