GRADUATE SCHOOL POLICY

Revised Commencement Participation Policy that would allow graduate students who finish all degree requirements in the summer to be eligible to participate in either the April or December commencement ceremony.

New Credit for Prior Learning Policy that would allow Oakland University graduate students to be awarded graduate level Credit for Prior Learning by meeting the equivalent knowledge required by the department.

New policy for Oakland University Academic Digital Badges that represent a level of achievement in a credit-bearing course(s) or assessed course assignments. Assessment of the learned skill is required.

New Dual Degree Program Policy that allows for two distinct graduate degree programs to be combined into one program via intentionally designed curricular coursework that results in two graduate degree diplomas or for two graduate degree programs to maintain their distinction as separate programs but be pursued simultaneously and result in two graduate degree diplomas. In addition to allowing dual degrees between Oakland University and a different institution as an agreement where two graduate degrees are conferred, one by each of the institutions.

New Expedited Graduate Application for Current Oakland University Students is a policy that would allow current Oakland University undergraduate students with at least a 3.0 undergraduate GPA or graduate students with at least a 3.0 graduate GPA to utilize the expedited graduate application in applying to participating programs.

Combined Undergraduate/Graduate Degree Program Policy revision that adds graduate certificates and doctoral degrees to the definition of a combined bachelor/graduate program. The revision also updates the undergraduate GPA requirement from 3.2 to 3.0 at the time of application, and removes the limited on when programs may allow a student to apply to a combined program. The revised policy updates the allowable amount of credits that can be double counted depending on the type of graduate program, and allows for the double-counting of coursework numbered 5000 or above. (NOTE: This policy was approved by Graduate Council and UCUI, and will be on the September 2023 Senate agenda.)

2022-2023 Statistics

- 47 items were submitted to Graduate Council
- 43 or 91% required approval
- Of the 43 that required approval: 28% were new certificate programs and 28% were new combined undergraduate/graduate programs
- Number of Submissions by School/College: SBA 5, SEHS 9, SHS 7, SON 1, OUWB 1, SECS 18 (MD/MPH is double counted since both degrees are graduate level)

Compared to 2021-2022 Annual Report

- 41 non-policy items, compared to 24 (21-22)
