Many of the modern amenities in the 100-room home, built between 1926 and 1929 for the sum of \$4 million, are not traditionally found even in today's contemporary mansions. From the in-house telephone operator to the electric elevator, visitors will be amazed to hear of the novelties the 88,000-square-foot home had to offer.

The Thoroughly Modern Tillie Tour focuses on the innovative conveniences and modern facilities of Meadow Brook Hall, while also bringing to the forefront the many accomplishments of the woman who commissioned this historic mansion.

"Matilda Dodge Wilson was a very modern woman, from the activities in which she was involved to the ideals she held," said Sally Victor, executive director of Meadow Brook Hall. "Without her vision, Meadow Brook Hall would not have existed today. We are extremely pleased to be able to further introduce Matilda to our guests, to give them new insights into her pioneering spirit and the cultural legacy she left behind."
