- approval of the auxiliary activities operating budgets for FY 2003, 2004 and 2005
- revisions to the gift policy for donor recognition
- approval of board members for the public school academies
- the addition of seventh and eighth grades to the curriculum of the Dove Academy of Detroit
- the addition of the Detroit Academy of Arts and Sciences as an Oakland University public school academy
