- recommendation to accept gifts to Oakland University and the Oakland University Foundation for the period of Sept. 1 through Oct. 31, 2003, and to accept grants and contracts to Oakland University for the period of Sept. 1 through Oct. 31, 2003;
- approval of honorary degree for Sen. Carl Levin;
- approval of Golf and Learning Center operating budget for fiscal years ending Dec. 31, 2004, 2005 and 2006;
- approval of fiscal year 2004-05 operating budget request for submission to the Department of Management and Budget of the State of Michigan;
- approval of capital outlay budget request fiscal year 2005, five-year plan;
- approval of amendments to the personnel manual to combine all administrative professional and individual contract employees into a single employee group.
