2011-2012	99	129

During this reporting period, 99 cases were submitted involving 129 students. There were 63 transfer students compared to 71 for the 2010-2011 academic year. Of the 129 students, **98** were deemed responsible and **1** was found not responsible. There are 9 cases pending involving 10 students.

There were four appeals for this reporting period. Appeal considerations are based on two criteria: significant procedural error or new evidence not available at the time of the hearing. Four appeals were denied because appeal criterion was not met. Only students who participate in the Academic Conduct Committee Hearing process have the right of appeal.
