OUWB Publication List: 2018 Preliminary Report

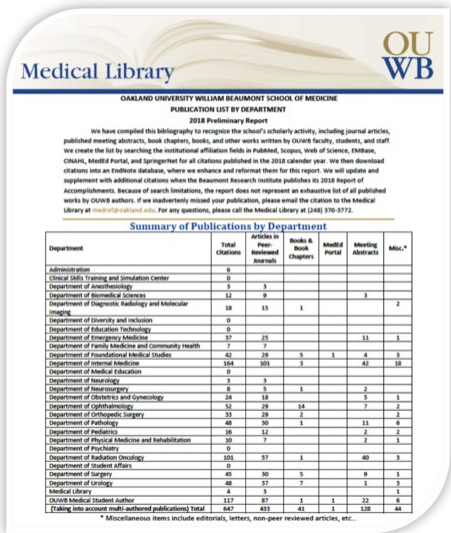
The Medical Library is pleased to publish the preliminary **2018 OUWB Publication Report** featuring the published work of our OUWB faculty, staff, and students!

This year's report features 647 citations including 433 peer-reviewed articles, 128 published meeting abstracts, 41 books & book chapters, and 117 student-authored works. In addition, OUWB faculty published the most in these five journals:

- Neurourology and Urodynamics
- American Journal of Emergency Medicine
- Journal of Cardiovascular Computed Tomography
- International Journal of Radiation Oncology, Biology, Physics
- International Urology and Nephrology

The following publication types are sometimes missed through our automated process: books, book chapters, and non-indexed articles. We will finalize the report with additional citations when the Beaumont Research Institute publishes its 2018 Report of Accomplishments.

We have compiled this bibliography to recognize the school's scholarly activity, including journal articles, published meeting abstracts, book chapters, books, and other works written by OUWB faculty, students, and staff. We create the list by searching the institutional affiliation fields in PubMed, Scopus, Web of Science, Embase, CINAHL, Medline Plus, and Springer for all citations published in the 2018 calendar year. We then download citations into an EndNote database, where we enhance and reformat them for this report. We will update and supplement with additional citations when the Beaumont Research Institute publishes its 2018 Report of Accomplishments. Because of search limitations, the report does not represent an exhaustive list of all published works by OUWB authors. Join us in the Collaborative Study Room (located on the first floor of Kresge Library) to mingle with our new students, share light refreshments, and kick off the new academic year!

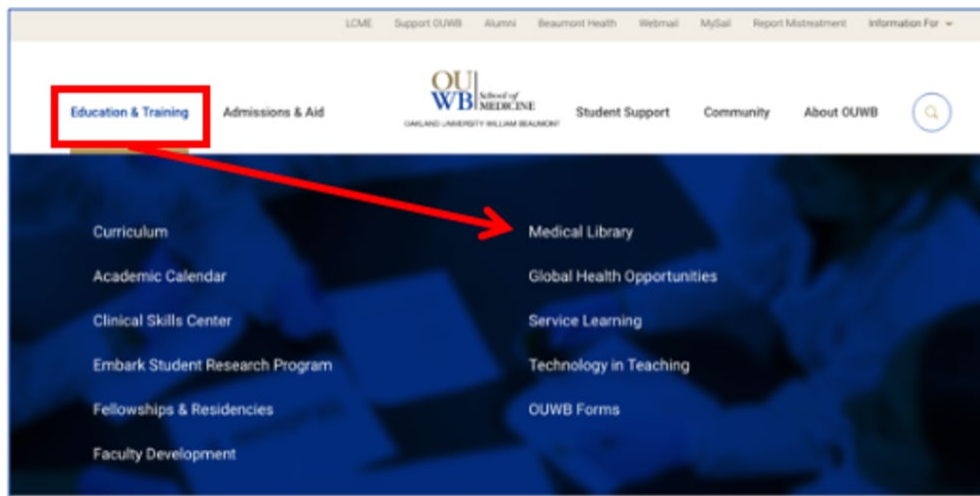

Student InfoBite Series

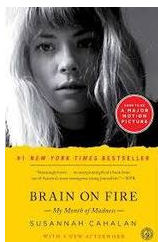

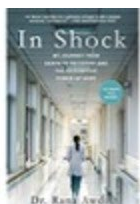
End the Summer with a Good Read!

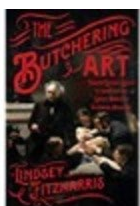
Brain on Fire: My Month of Madness by Susannah Cahalan

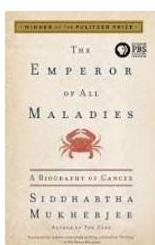

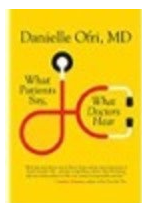
