The effort was a collaboration of several groups on campus and led by Jean Ann Miller and the Office for Student Involvement.

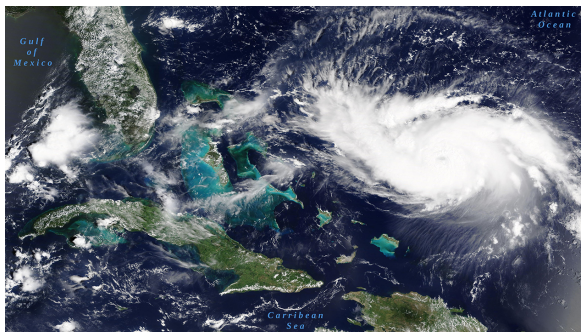
