Students, organizations honored at award ceremony

Oakland University students, advisers, faculty, staff and parents gathered April 18 in the Oakland Center Banquet Rooms to recognize the Student and Greek Organizations Award winners for the 2003-2004 academic year.

"It's important to recognize excellent work throughout the academic year," said Jean Ann Miller, director of the Center for Student Activities. "The students did an outstanding job this past year, and we don't want them to go unnoticed. Plus, it's a great way to motivate other students and organizations to be nominated or nominate themselves for next year's awards and accolades."

Award winners are self-nominated or nominated by organizations, advisers and fellow students. Certificates, pins, and in some cases, financial awards were distributed to the winners.

In addition to the Student Organization Awards, the Volunteer Service Award, Commuter Involvement Award and Sidney Fink Memorial Award winners also were announced.

"This is the first time the **Center for Student Activities** has handled the nomination and selection process for these awards and publicly announced the recipients at the Student and Greek Organizations Recognition Night," Miller said. "This is the start of a new tradition at this annual event."

About 200 people attended the 26th annual awards reception, featuring the theme "An Affair to Remember." The semiformal evening featured appetizers, desserts, a jazz ensemble and ended with a hypnotist working his magic onstage with students.

"We received a lot of positive feedback from the students," said Christina Tierman, coordinator of student organizations and Greek life. "This was the first time it was semi-formal, and they really enjoyed the opportunity to get dressed up for the celebration."
