## Campus parking lot to be repaved

In a continuing effort to maintain and improve campus parking facilities, Oakland University will repave parking lot 36, located between Dodge Hall, Kresge Library, Elliott Hall and Varner Hall.

The lot will be closed to all traffic beginning Saturday, July 19, while the repaving project begins Monday, July 21, and is expected to be completed by late August.

"Portions of the lot had deteriorated badly. The worst area is the southern end of the lot and the remainder also shows signs of deterioration," said Assistant Vice President for Facilities Management Rusty Postlewate. "The lot will remain closed to all vehicle traffic while construction is under way, but special deliveries to the Kresge Library loading dock will be accommodated."

During the construction period, ample parking will remain available in lots 24 (south of Varner Hall), 32 and 34 (south of lot 36) and 38 (south of the Science and Engineering Building).
