In celebration of Black History Month, the third annual SEHS Black Faculty Research Symposium will be held on Monday February 6, 2017 from 4-6 p.m. in the Oakland Center Oakland Room. This symposium provides a forum for Oakland University faculty and students to share their completed African American research and related research in progress. De Witt Dykes, associate professor in the History Department of OU's College of Arts and Sciences will be the keynote speaker. His keynote speech is entitled, *Is History a Guide for the Future? 1890-2016*.



Additional presenters include Alicia Freeman and Eleanor Glass, who are both SEHS doctoral students. Alicia Freeman (Counseling) will be presenting on Exploring Stereotype Threats in Multicultural Counseling Courses.
